AN INVITATION



South Asian Institute for Advanced Research and Development (SAIARD) and the School of Tribal Resource Management, KISS, Bhubaneswar, Odisha are jointly going to organize an International Conference on '**Environmental Sustainability & Tribal Development**' on 24th - 25th August, 2019 at KISS-KIIT Campus. Members of all teaching fraternity, researchers and academia from different disciplines are cordially invited to present their research papers in the conference.

FOCAL THEME

Tribals are "a social group living in a definite area with a dialect cultural homogeneity and unifying social organisation", In India the tribals generally inhabit in hilly and inaccessible areas. These groups of tribals are known as Girijans' which means tribal people living in hills and mountain ranges. Girijan tribe is a group comprising families, clans or generations having its own customs, occupying a special geographic territory, and being independent of, or having little contact with the dominant national society of the country in which they live. For generations, indigenous people worldwide have believed that any decisions they make should take into consideration the effects on future descendants—the next seven generations. This "seventh generation" philosophy currently is garnering more attention in regard to sustainable development. Societies worldwide are addressing issues such as deterioration of the environment, diminishing natural resources, energy shortages, pollution, growing populations and traffic congestion, among others.

In 1987, a United Nations commission studied the effects of development on populations worldwide and provided its definition of sustainability, which has become the most commonly used definition and wholly reflects the seventh generation philosophy that many American Indian and Alaska Natives have held for centuries: 'A sustainable society meets the needs of the present without sacrificing the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.' —The World Commission on Environment and Development. Concern about the lifestyle future generations will face has prompted the need to develop sustainability planning and development in communities nationwide. Sustainable development—sometimes considered to pertain only to the environment—also includes societal and economic factors. In addressing sustainability, obvious issues come to mind—climate change, water conservation, waste management and land use. Less obvious, yet relevant, issues to consider that affect everyday life include poverty, transportation, consumerism, human health, agriculture, housing and education.

The abstract must carry the authors name, designation, affiliation, contact number with STD or ISD code (e.g. +91-9800012345) and email id. The abstract must contain a brief introduction, objectives, methodology, database, major findings and keywords.

The authors may submit their full length paper after getting the letter of acceptance of abstract from the organizers. In that case the format of the full length paper will be the same as the abstract. The full paper must not exceed 7 pages including all the tables, diagrams, maps, references, title and particulars related to the author(s). It is highly expected that the contributions should be authentic as per the research ethics of anti-plagiarism. PUBLICATION

The abstracts and papers will be accepted after the process of review by an expert committee and on the basis of their recommendations, selected number of papers will be published either in an UGC recognised journal or an Edited book volume with proper ISBN number and for that an additional charges of Rs. **1500/-** (fifteen hundred) will be applicable.
