- Submit your articles/case studies within **500 - 2000 words**.
- **KEYWORDS**, subject to a maximum of five, which should be arranged in alphabetic order separated by commas and full stop at the end.
- **TITLE** (14-point Times New Roman)
- **Authors' names** (12-point Times New Roman), Designations, affiliation/ address, telephone number and email id (10-point Times New Roman)
- **CONTENT**, 12 Font Size (Times New Roman style) and 1.15 spacing
- **DOCUMENT TYPES ALLOWED: Word Document but not in pdf**
- The articles may be based on **primary or secondary sources**
- In case of case based on primary source, **consent/clearance to publish the case will be required from the company/organisation/individual**.
- Submit a **teaching note along with the case is mandatory**.
- Author(s) should **avoid plagiarism (Max. 10%)** in order to maintain the standard of the publication.

ABOUT THE EDITORS

Prof. Suresh Chand Rai, Professor and Head, Department of Geography, Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi, did his Master of Science in Geography from Banaras Hindu University in 1979 and also awarded Ph.D. degree in Geography from Banaras Hindu University in 1984. Prof. Rai was served as Scientist in G.B. Pant Institute of Himalayan Environment and Sustainable Development (An Autonomous Institute of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India) from 1989-April 2005. His significant contributions are in the field of land and water resource management, watershed management, wetland ecosystem and groundwater hydrology. His work has been outstanding on the Integrated Watershed Management in the Sikkim Himalaya have been recognized through the Soil and Water Conservation Society of USA, Award, 1999. He was also involved in Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India on various projects. He has published more than 100 research papers in various Impact Factor/Peer-Reviewed Journals and books (Scopus Citation Index-583; h-index-16). Prof. Rai received "Life Time Achievement Award, 2019", "Professor Bandaru Hema Malini Eminent Geographers Award- 2013", En-gratis Membership Awarded by Ecological Society of America, from 1999 to 2004. Since 2010, he is serving as Secretary General of National Association of Geographers, India (NAGI), the largest society of the Geographers in India. Prof. Rai was elected Vice President of Asian Geographical Society, Headquarters at Beijing, P.R. China for four years (2019-2023).

Prof. Sunil Kumar De, (M.Sc. 1989 & Ph.D., 1999, University of Calcutta, India) is a Professor & Head of the Department of Geography, North Eastern Hill University, Shillong, India. His major fields of interest are Geomorphological Hazards (especially landslide & soil erosion), fluvial dynamics and human impact on environment. He has completed 05 (five) Major Research Projects, published 65 research papers in different national and internationally reputed journals and book chapters. He has edited two books on Geomorphology and Environment and co-authored a book on "River Health" (Springer). He has received National (1987-89) and UNESCO (2002) Scholarships. Before joining in North Eastern Hill University (2013), Prof. De taught in the Department of Geography and Disaster Management, Tripura University, India as Reader from 2006-2013, became Head of the same Department for the period 2010-2012 and Union Christian Training College, West Bengal, India during the period 2000-2006. He has served as the Executive Committee Member (2001-2004), Joint Secretary (2005-2008) and Vice President (2017-2018) of the Indian Institute of Geomorphologists (IGI). Since 2008, he has been acting as the International Correspondence Secretary of the same Institute. He was elected as the Publication Officer of International Association of Geomorphologists (IAG/AIG) for the period 2009-2013, Secretary General for the period 2013-2017, Vice President of the IAG/AIG for the period 2017-2021 and was the Vice-Chair of the IAG Working group on Geomorphological Hazards (2005-2015). He was the convener of the 9th International Conference on Geomorphology, which was held at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi during 6-11 November, 2017.

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
